**Nominations**, which must be in writing and comply with the registered rules of the Organisation, may be made at any time from 12:00pm Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) 04/10/2019.

A person eligible to nominate for election is a person who was financial at the time of nomination and;

- for the position of President, Vice President and Divisional Councillor, has attended 25% of the meetings of his/her Sub Branch in the twelve months immediately preceding the closing date for nominations, provided that sitting members of the Divisional Council whose absence from their Sub Branch meeting has been due to their attendance at meetings of the Council, shall not be required to have completed such attendance.
- for the positions of President, Vice President and Divisional Councillor, is a person who complies with the rule above and has twelve months financial membership of the Union.
- for all other positions, was a financial member of the Union 30 days before the starting time for nominations.

Nominations must reach the Returning Officer via the lodgement method(s) stipulated below **not later than** 12:00pm Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) **on** 01/11/2019. Additional forms are available from the Returning Officer.

**Withdrawing Nominations**

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after 12:00pm Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on 08/11/2019.

**Candidate Statements**

Candidates may submit a statement to be included with ballot material. Only statements which comply with the Rules and are received by the Returning Officer by 12:00pm (Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST)) on 01/11/2019 can be accepted.

**Voting Period**

The ballot, if required, will open on 11/11/2019 and close at 12:00pm Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on 02/12/2019. The ballot will be decided by a first-past-the-post system on voting.

**Scrutineers**

The appointment of scrutineers opens 11/11/2019 and closes 12:00pm Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on 02/12/2019. A form is available from the Returning Officer for the purposes of appointing Scrutineers.
