## We Presented Your Petition

Yesterday, both unions attended Parliament house and met with the Minister of Transport to hand him the 1850 strong petition signed by you. While there we also spoke to him and advisors about how the current legislation proposed by the Office of National Rail Safety Regulator (ONRSR) is all about the companies and not about the workers.

Minister of Transport, Mark Bailey advised he recently attended the National Transport Ministers Council meeting and he made it clear to the other Ministers the issues he also had with the current legislation.

This has occurred as a result of our campaign and we will now have a greater say in what is proposed and ONRSR will continue to meet with unions over the coming months.

We remain opposed to the invasion of your privacy and how you can be spied upon by Rail Operators.
