The position will be based in Brisbane and your primary duties will be recruiting assisting and training members. You will be required to assist in all forms of dispute resolution including before the Fair Work Commission and you may be required to participate in or lead enterprise agreement negotiations.

There is a requirement to travel regularly across the state to meet and service members employed by a raft of different rail operators across all QLD regions.

The AFULE will undertake to provide the successful candidate with relevant training.

The Organiser we are seeking must demonstrate:

- A passion and drive to improve workers' lives and achieving the goals of the AFULE.
- Good communication, messaging and rapport building skills;
- An ability to develop members, including motivating and educating others;
- An ability to participate in the unions political and social justice agenda;
- An ability to plan and organise work and achieve outcomes.
