The AFULE have been engaged in negotiations with Pacific National Coal for close to nine months to reach a new Enterprise Agreement (EA) for all members.

Member feedback early on during bargaining was that conditions were the main priority during these negotiations, and with a lot of hard work we have achieved this.

The AFULE believe this is a fair outcome based on the current industrial climate and are encouraging members to vote YES to the proposal.

PN informed your state office late last Thursday that “roadshows” to highlight changes to traincrew would commence this week.

Your state organiser, Thomas O’Rourke, who was at the bargaining table for the entirety of bargaining will be at Sarina, Coppabella, and Bowen depots to attend the roadshows as communicated by PN, and to also field your questions.
